PROJECT: RFQ 24-20-SSP Moffitt IT App Development and Management Request for Qualifications for Continuous Services

An overview of the RFQ was given by Ashish Jain and Daniel Zichello.

- 1) Please elaborate on Section 2, is the \$750k per project?
 - a. Yes
- 2) Can you define nearshore, offshore, onshore and do you have a preference?
 - a. All three offerings would be ideal based on project needs: new development and KTLO work.
- 3) Is there a preference for app maintenance/support – nearshore, onsite?
 - a. It will depend on the role for the project – e.g., big release may need some roles onsite.
- 4) What is the overall scope, is this for a specific product or solution? What products are you looking for? Are there specific requirements or products?
 - a. Please include as much information on your background and capabilities.
- 5) Is the tech help desk in scope here?
 - a. No, most resources will be Level 2 app support.
- 6) What is your tech stack?
 - a. Hosting/on prem – we are hybrid depending on the app in the system; the new systems being implemented are cloud based. Small footprint on AWS on the data side; low code platforms (PEGA/Outsystems); legacy apps are on on-prem hosted; Snowflake for data marts, PEGA Optimizely.
- 7) Code stack – App Dev?
 - a. MS .NET; not Azure DevOps; going more in platform direction.
- 8) Section 7 Question 25 regarding network connectivity, does this RFQ also include Infa services to build/own/manage the infrastructure?
 - a. We'll expect coordination with our internal network/infra teams.
- 9) What is your roadmap/types of projects coming up?
 - a. Digital transformation, basic capabilities, enablers, foundational, e.g., mobile app, CRM, website. Additional areas are patient facing – in research, KTLO support, etc.
- 10) Are you also evaluating your core EMR system?
 - a. That is yet to be determined and is not part of this RFQs scope.
- 11) Would you consider vendors with only onshore staffing?



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- a. We are looking for suppliers with multiple options based on the project.
- 12) Do you require the hourly rate of team members in response to this RFQ?
 - a. We expect the standard rate card.
- 13) What would be the cost of budget allocation, towards app or app support?
 - a. It depends on the type of project, i.e., development vs. support. Transformation efforts are large-scale efforts, we would assume that a development team of less than 20 people plus a few app support resources will be needed.
- 14) Post RFQ, what will be the type of participation? Multi-vendor collaboration or a project given to a single vendor?
 - a. No more than 2 vendors will collaborate on any given project.
- 15) Do you have any needs for UX?
 - a. Yes, we expect the vendors to have all type of resources i.e., UX, Analytics, Product Managers, Front End Developers, FS Developers, etc.
- 16) Would you be interested in looking at AQ Automation?
 - a. Yes.
- 17) How many vendors do you expect to have?
 - a. The scope of the RFQ is to have a pool of vendors to support Moffitt's needs. We haven't identified the exact number but that will be determined upon receipt of the proposals.
- 18) Can we participate in the RFQ is we are a 5-year-old company?
 - a. Eight years was set to gauge maturity, if you can demonstrate that level of maturity you are welcome to submit a proposal.
- 19) Are we limited to a 20-page proposal?
 - a. Yes, the 20 pages must include your rate card, but Appendix 1 can be uploaded separately and will not count towards the 20-page page limit.

Colette Glover-Hannah reminded vendors to fill out and submit Appendix 1 as well as any additional information relevant to vendor's diversity initiatives.

Trillany announced that emailed questions would be welcomed through Wednesday, March 6th and closed the meeting.
