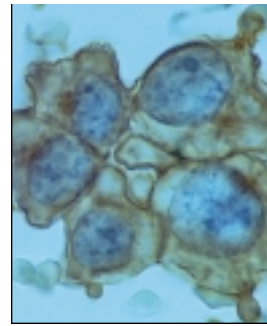


IN THE NEXT ISSUE
